### Catholic Charities Foreclose Prevention Seminar

Catholic Charities Foreclosure Prevention Program is currently screening potential participants for free seminars in English and Spanish on Foreclosure Prevention on Saturday February 13. The seminar is geared to homeowners who fear default or who are already in default of their mortgages, and will focus on understanding the options and ramifications of loan modifications or bankruptcy. There will be two presentations at 987 Airway Court: English presentation: 9:30 a.m.-1:00 p.m., Spanish presentation: 1:30-5:00 p.m. There is no charge to attend, but potential participants are required to contact Catholic Charities Housing Department at 575-0215 to obtain an intake questionnaire.
