2010 Diocesan Mission Cooperative Plan

Next weekend, Sr. Roseanna Mellert, with the Sisters of Notre Dame, will speak at all the Masses about their mission in Nicaragua. At the invitation of Bishop Carlos Enrique Herrera, the Chardon province of the Sisters of Notre Dame began a mission in Nicaragua on July 26, 2008. Four North American sisters went to Jinotega to minister in the parish of Sangre de Cristo in El Llano de las Tejas with the goal of spreading the Gospel message and empowering lay leadership. With financial help from Food for the Poor and the American Nicaraguan Foundation, a simple convent and a parish community center were built. The sisters ministering here serve the parish of Sangre de Cristo, as well as many mission communities and villages in the mountains. This area is among the poorest in Nicaragua, which is the second-poorest country in the Western Hemisphere. Nicaragua is the first mission of the Sisters of Notre Dame in Central America. A second collection will be taken up to assist their work.
