Whooping Cough Update

Sonoma County Public Health will provide *free* Pertussis (whooping cough) vaccines in Room A of the parish hall on Sunday, Sept. 12th, 8:00 a.m.-2:30 p.m. Pertussis (whooping cough) is at epidemic levels in California. The disease causes coughing fits that make it hard to breathe. It spreads easily when someone with the disease coughs or sneezes. It can kill young babies. Everyone needs to be up-to-date on their whooping cough vaccination. New-born babies are too young for the vaccine. Protection from whooping cough vaccination wears off, so Public Health recommends that people 11 years and older need a booster shot every 5 years.
