Annual Ministry Appeal Sunday

All parish households are encouraged to support The Annual Ministry Appeal for 2019. All the parishes in the diocese are currently involved in raising the money that is needed to support 18 Diocesan Ministries. The support can be in the form of a ten-month pledge or a one-time donation. Pledges are encouraged for those in a position to do so. St. Rose's goal is \$53,094.00. We must make 90% of the goal. If not, the difference will have to be paid out of the regular parish funds. Our confidence in making our goal is based on the exceptional generosity of the parishioners to the 2018 Ministry Appeal. Last year's goal was \$58,458. An additional \$17,700 was raised. This was returned to the parish. This money will be used to improve the security and safety of the parish plant. Cameras will be installed during the next few weeks. All who have not yet participated this year have the opportunity today. During all the Masses households will be asked to make a pledge or donation. Together we will make our goal. All the money raised in excess of the goal will be returned to the parish. Now is the time to help your parish make its goal and to be a vital part of the 18 Ministries. Fifty percent of the money donated is designated for local Diocesan needs. In Santa Rosa this money is given to Catholic Charities. Funds collected by Catholic Relief Services (CRS) allows that agency to provide funding for international emergency needs, such as the Typhoon in the Philippines, water wells in Ethiopia, and the rights of immigrants. This is an excellent way to practice Lenten almsgiving.
